Our art classes run during the school term Monday to Friday from 10-12pm. Tuesdays & Thursdays 1-3pm. All materials (paints, easels, brushes, aprons) are provided. Your canvas can be ordered directly from Claremont Art Framers 0411 220 018 or you could purchase one from your local art store.

Once you begin, your canvas will be stored after each class to dry, ready for your return each week.

Cost \$140 (incl GST) per two hour lesson. Only five students per class, with the commitment of one class per week. Should you need to reschedule or make up a class during the term, this can always be arranged, preferably with as much prior notice as possible in order for us to diarise and let other students know, so they too can shuffle accordingly.

CHER BIOGRAPHY

Passionate from the beginning about expressing life through art, dance, poetry and friendship. Cher formally studied art for three years at The PJ Olivier School of Arts, under the guidance of Vernon Swart in Stellenbosch South Africa.

After her first - sell out - exhibition in Hong Kong 1993, Cher went on to study Journalism at Rhodes University and then Interior Design at The White House School of Design.

Travelling widely in Europe and United States during the 2001/2, much of their time was spent in the Cape, where they settled from 2002 - 2007, there Cher worked with a body of Eastern Cape Artists of extraordinary talent.

In 2007 Cher and her family moved to Perth, Australia, teaching at NCWA as well as opening her own Studio, sharing her love of art.

Whilst continuing a solo art career, Cher continues to encourage students /upcoming artists to paint largely with a palette knife, in successive layers, intensifying textures and enjoying the pulsating effect of the paint on canvas. Influenced by the Art of Photography, Cher is able to capture the play of light and shadow – able to maintain subtlety and intimacy of the moment in each canvas.

Cher has been nominated Artist of the Year, plus featured in television art shows. She has caught the attention of the global art scene and secured invitations to exhibit in solo shows in London, Africa, United States and Australia.

Cher taught at the Neurological Council for Western Australia (NCWA) for over two years and has currently been invited to represent one of our leading fashion design houses internationally.
